
6 The 6 Days of Creation

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. Genesis 1:1,2



Let us begin to discuss how Moses describes the **Creation Process** in the book of **Genesis**. Moses, being a Hebrew and the receiver of the Written Law, was very familiar with six days of work and one day of rest **cycle**. He was the one that instructed millions of Hebrews that this was God's command. It is in this **same fashion** that he presents the **Creation Process**. It should be noted that there are many theories on the creation of the world in various belief systems. We should also note that science and the Judeo/Christian belief system do agree on outline but do not align surrounding timing of Creation. The rest of this discussion shall focus on:

The Spiritual Key Points of Creation

- The World was void and without form and was shaped by a Designer. Something came from ABSOLUTELY NOTHING
- The Creator fashioned everything in the Universe in and evolving systematic process
- Each thing that God made was integral for the next things that He made. Example: the sun was key to the growth of plants/grasses so it was made before
- The living organisms had the ability to reproduce their own kind with seed from within
- God made multiples of everything that He made including Humans
- God saved His Greatest Creation for last. The Creation of Mankind was God's Ultimate Goal and everything else was created and ready for man when we arrived in the Universe
- Mankind was the only part creation that was made in the Image of God
- The combination of the male and female (with masculine, feminine & neutral traits) make up what Genesis calls "Man" and is the Image of God
- Everything that God created in its original state was Good
- Everything in Creation transcends borders, religion, ethnicity, politics, race, wealth or anything else that mankind uses to separate ourselves



With the world beautifully and incredibly fashioned, we may ask ourselves the question "Why did the All Mighty and Powerful God go to so much fuss to make the majestic Universe and our little corner of it called Earth filled with splendor and living creatures." And some of these living beings were made in His image. Why? This question may never be fully understood, but I shall supply you with the simple answer. God wanted His only begotten Son to have "like image freewill" beings that He could fellowship with. We shall discuss in later writings the subjects of 'like image' and 'freewill'. But for now we shall do as God did after Moses' day number six.... Stop, look around at everything in the Universe, and see that in its original natural state..... It is Good.
