The Guilty Headlines



The 2016 Global Slavery Index published by the Walk Free Foundation estimates that **45.8 million** *neighbors* are in some form of **slavery** in 167 countries. This is not some softened, by-modern-standards definition of slavery. These *neighbors* are living as **forced** laborers, **forced** prostitutes, **child** soldiers, **child** brides in **forced** marriages and, in all ways that matter, as pieces of **property**. In 1981, Mauritania became the last country in the world to abolish slavery yet slavery is alive and growing today while the WORLD watches.




Based on national reports, it's estimated that no less than **150** million *neighbors*, or about 2 percent of the world's population, are homeless. However, about **1.6 billion**, more than 20 percent of the world's population, may lack adequate housing. According to World Health Organization (WHO) data from 2015, **2.3 billion** *neighbors* are living without a toilet worldwide while 10 percent of the *neighbors* meet their toilet needs out in the open.



Every second a *neighbor* **dies of hunger**. Right now, more than 1 billion *neighbors* suffer from hunger. This means that 1 in every 6 *neighbors* on Earth don't get enough food to live a healthy life. This year **36 million** of these *neighbors* will die of hunger!
